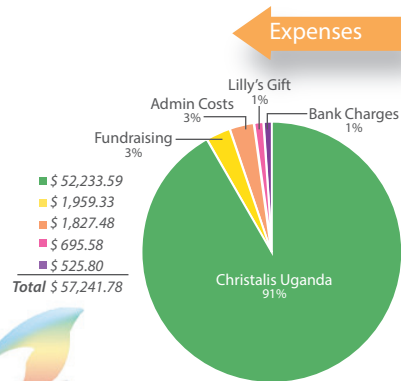
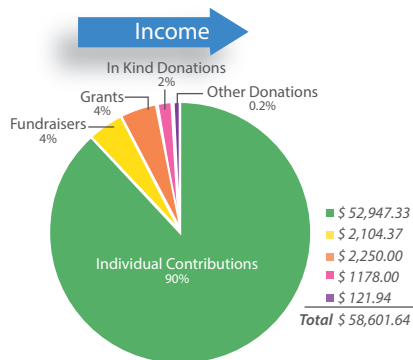

## 2012 Financial Highlights



*All fundraising and administrative costs were covered 100% by board members.*

### Lilly's Gifts (USA)

We were able to provide over 120 children with 2-3 Christmas gifts each through Lilly's Gifts. These children were in shelters or low income rec centers:



### Christalis Home (Uganda)

30 Children who were abandoned and destitute were provided 24/7 care in the Christalis Home. The home provided shelter, education, meals, clothing and most of all love.



We took in 3 siblings who were being cared for by their disabled 23-year old brother. All he could give them was one meal a day. The two younger children had severe case of scabies covering both hands and legs but their brother was unable to pay for their medical care. Since coming to our home they have received medical care, started school and get 3 meals a day.



We also took in a 21 year old mother with twin daughters who were 3 and a four month old. She was abandoned by her husband while she was pregnant. Since joining our home she has learned to make sweaters and is working on her first small contract for making a few sweaters for a nearby school.

### Assistance Program (Uganda)

The Assistance Program provided 31 children with school tuition, uniforms, books, school supplies, medical costs and other basic needs. Here are two of the children that were helped by this program.



Junior Brian, seen on the far left in red shorts, lives with his grandparents and cousin in their home.



Yoneki lives with her sister and mother in this home and walks about four kilometers to school and back each day. She is always focused on attending school.

### Meal Program (Uganda)

Our meal program provided two meals a day to 15 starving children who live in the area of our home.
