Our Home provides shelter, food, clothing, education, healthcare and a loving family environment where children who are orphaned, abandoned, or victims of challenging circumstances. Our home operates like a close knit family in the sense that the children live in a family-style environment, where the children reside in a building with both a paternal and maternal figure, and "aunts" who provide love, care, meals, counseling, guidance, discipline and nurture. A typical day in our children's life includes: school, study time, reading time, play time, chores. We also use various methods to instill a positive attitude and help our children progress to achieving their goals and dreams. We do this through seminars and incentive-based strategies that are built into their daily routine.
